Medication Viewer Update

Dear NDHIN Participants and Users,

Last year, North Dakota Health Information Network (NDHIN) was made aware by a third-party vendor used to provide medication history through our platform that the service would no longer be available to health information exchanges in 2026. In November 2024, the vendor made the decision to retire a legacy interface which hosted NDHIN's connection to their data. NDHIN realizes the value and importance of this data to your organization's operations and held multiple meetings with the vendor to restore connection or find alternative means to provide prescription data to our participants. Unfortunately, after much discussion, NDHIN was unsuccessful, and we will no longer be able to offer medication history on our platform. We thank you for your patience and understanding in this matter. We understand the value of this data to healthcare operations and will continue to search for alternative solutions in the future.

Heidi Reiter, pulmonary nurse practitioner, CHI St. Alexius Health Heart & Lung Clinic shares with NDHIN specific data she finds helpful within the Clinical Portal that has become a valuable tool in her daily practice.

- CT chest reports
- Lab flowsheets for trends
- Office visits for respiratory illnesses
- Pathology reports to confirm/support diagnosis and treatment plan
- Older data that is not found in her facility's EHR this is especially important in determining if a lung nodule is new vs. stable for several years

Heidi encourages users to click around, information is there, but not always where you expect it.

Opportunities for Providers when using NDHIN:

Access to Comprehensive Patient Records:

Medical history, including past diagnoses, medications, procedures, and lab results can be found, even if the patient received care from outside providers or facilities. NDHIN has an External Records tab within the Clinical Portal that connects users to the eHealth exchange, the largest health information exchange infrastructure within the U.S.

Improved Continuity of Care:

For patients that require visits to multiple specialists and healthcare facilities, NDHIN supports a comprehensive and coordinated approach to care. By having access to previous encounters, providers can customize treatment plans specific to their patient's need and avoid unnecessary testing and/or procedures.

Quick Access to Information:


Not only does NDHIN streamline access to critical patient health information within the Clinical Portal, but they also offer other means of protected health information (PHI) retrieval through their Direct Secure Messaging (DSM) service. This service helps to eliminate delays associated with manual record retrieval or fax. Having information at your fingertips is crucial when dealing with emergency situations where data is needed quickly and vital to patient outcomes.
